I understand that a failure to maintain the equipment in operational condition, or sale of the equipment, before 3 years have elapsed, will result in a prorated repayment of cost share money, to be paid to the Peace River Soil and Water Conservation District (PRSWCD).

Furthermore:

- PRSWCD staff shall be permitted to inspect the equipment for operational and ownership status at least once per year.
- The cooperater will keep records of when the equipment is used and the # of acres covered during each operation as required by the Peace River and Manasota Basin Citrus BMP Rule. This is for the purpose of reporting acres benefited to the funding agency (Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services)
- Grove caretakers must provide documentation showing that they are doing work for each grove claimed on the usage log sheet
